Proposed Draft of the Zoning Ordinance, Carly Marshall

Solar Farm language

- We discussed the importance of low profile groundcover that attracts pollinators.
- We agreed that the exemption language allowed for easier implementation of solar farms in agricultural areas.
- We discussed the importance of adding language about conservation district approval.

Carly updated recommendations from the last meeting.

- *Motion:* Adamik moved that we recommend to the supervisors to approve all red-line corrections in the zoning document. Sweezey seconded the motion and all were in favor with a 3-0 vote.

Butler Township Subdivision

Motion—Adamik moved that we recommend to the supervisors that we maintain the dedicated right-of-way precedence consistent with the current ordinance. Funt seconded the motion and all were in favor with a 3-0 vote.
