- 5. Solar Farm should be called Solar Field or Solar Array
- 6. Decommissioning Agreement and have 3rd party prepare not the solicitor
- 7. No lines of credit the company should provide cash % of the project
- 8. No tree removal should be allowed
- 9. Height of Units (10 ft is high enough)
- 10. Should be placed on the worst soils and slope is important
- 11. Industrial district is the best zoning district
- 12. Should be built in a way that emergency services would be able to maneuver around
- 13. Children's safety needs to be addressed
- 14. The panels cause weather pattern changes. (Micro Claimants)
- 15. Do they require environmental studies?
- 16. Why does the County and State not have a plan and help the Municipalities?
- 17. Is there a limit to how much Solar is allowed in an area?
